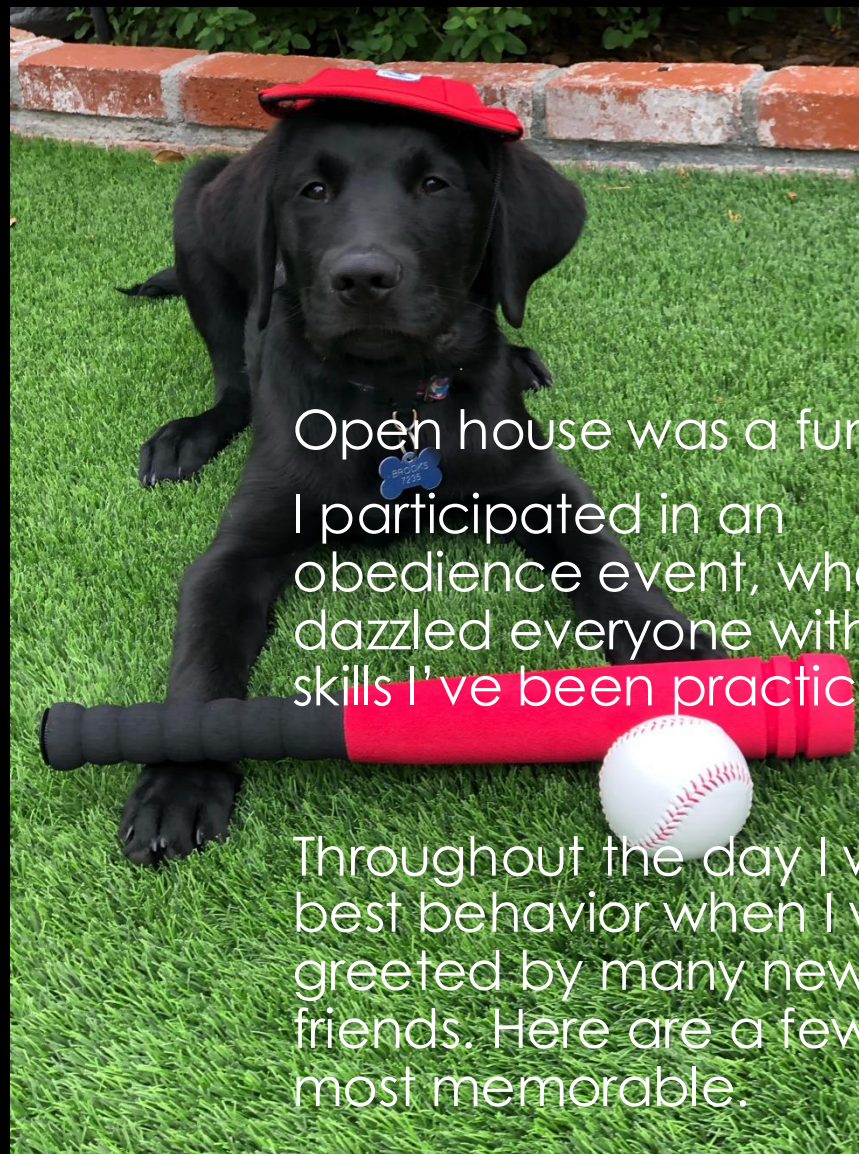
My Very First Holiday!

Socialization is an important aspect to becoming a guide or service dog.

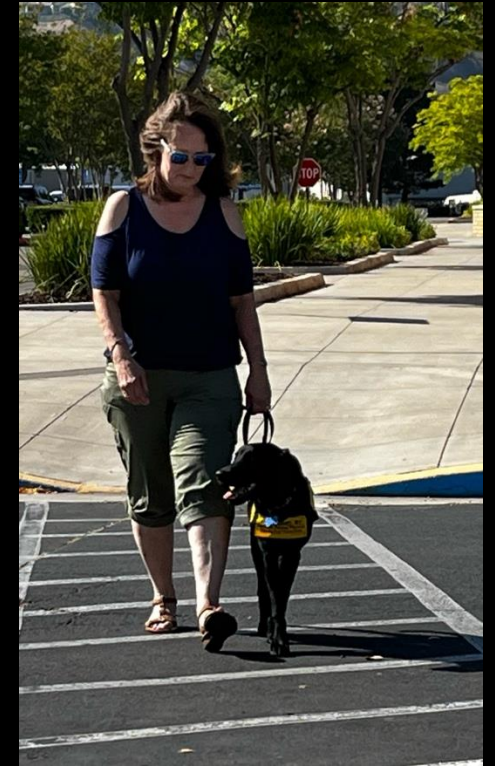
Here are few of my outings at different places I have visited with my raisers. At each of the places we visit, I practice my leash skills, calm greetings. Overall I practice being on my best behavior.
