



## **Quick Update**

 Lady has always been great with her house behaviors.



#### TIE DOWN


 Lady has been working on being on her tie down more often. She has improved greatly! She settles very quickly






#### **GRADUATION**

- She settled very well and stayed focused, despite all the attention from people and loud noises going on. She also settled very well under our table at dinner afterwards. A long day for her but she did so well!




### **CAR RIDES**


 Lady is an expert at riding in the car now. She much prefers to be in her comfy crate in the back but she also does well on the floor by the front passenger seat
